

BATLLÓ HOUSE

Sharing the Passeig de Gràcia is the Casa Milà Casa Batlló. Designed by Antoni Gaudí, is located inside corner of the famous "La Manzana de la Discòrdia", next to Casa Lleó Morera de Domènech i Montaner Amatller y House of Puig i Cadafalch.

The Casa Batlló is a building of 1877 that the textile fabricante Josep Batlló i Casanovas wanted to convert his residence, and Gaudí was responsible for such reform. The facade is covered with "trencadís of glass and pottery that the sun does shine during the day, and the balconies are forged. The building is crowned with a dragon Forna without heads and tails, with a white cross that is the end of a ladder that connects the top floor with buardilla. The rear facade is extended with an iron garden arches, ceramics and mosaics.
