

CENTRO - PLAZA DE ARMAS

It was the old railway station of the Plaza de Armas, also known as Station Cordova. It was built by the railway company of Madrid - Zaragoza - Alicante between 1898 and 1901. Its style is neo-Mudejar. It is now a shopping and leisure center that houses several theaters. Nearby is the newly constructed bus station square and the hotel of the same name.
