

PLAZA DE LA ENCARNACION DEL SIGLO XXI

A structure shaped like mushrooms together by six large cabinets that stretch from the outskirts of Bridge Street and Pellón to the streets of Regina has resulted in the winning idea of the international competition of ideas by the City Council convened in Seville Square the Incarnation.

The jury selected the proposal, drafted by the study of the German architect Jürgen Mayer



and an estimated cost of 33 million euros, a total of ten finalists, was placed second in the Union Office in Barcelona, This is Tomorrow, suggesting a high place and completely exposed and in the third position of the Dutch G. Uden M. B. H, Viridiana, where there was a triangular-shaped portion and supported by a large central building.

The architect Jürgen Mayer was pleased with the outcome of the contest, which was inspired by the ancient ficus that exist in the nearby Plaza Cristo de Burgos, prayed with structures that release the light and shade as well. He explained they have tried to create an icon for public enjoyment and invigorate this area of downtown.

Metropol Parasol has been designed by a team of five architects and has an estimated cost of executing 33 million, also explained the architect Andre Santer, who noted that it can be run in phases.

The German study must now conduct the project execution, which they estimated could take as a year, although the City Council intends to tender the works later this year. In terms of construction, estimated to be needed over two years.
